Apple News



- Apple's next major event will be held Wednesday, September 9th in San Francisco. Expected announcements include new iOS devices and final details on on the new iOS and OS/X software updates as well as ???.
- It's rumored that after Sept. 13, you'll be able to get AppleCare from Best Buy for the iPhone, iPad, Mac, and Apple Watch, the same services and benefits as AppleCare plans sold by Apple itself.
- Appointments are no longer necessary to try on Apple Watch. Walk-in customers now receive the same service for Apple Watch that they get for any other product.

Apple News



- Comcast has announced that it's testing an expansion of its low-cost Internet Essentials program for senior citizens in San Francisco and Palm Beach County, Florida. Internet Essentials offers download speeds of up to 10 Mbps and a Wi-Fi router for \$9.95 per month for low-income households.
- Beginning September 1, 2015, Amazon no longer accepts Flash ads on amazon's web sites. Another nail in the coffin for Flash!
- Best Buy will expand Apple Watch sales to all its stores in September. They initially expected to have the watches in 300 of its stores by the holiday season. But Best Buy has seen such strong demand for the Apple Watch, both in stores and online, that sales will be expanding to all 1,050 of its storefronts.

Apple Music Festival



- Apple's annual iTunes music Festival from London has been renamed the Apple Music Festival
- The 2015 Festival will include performances from Pharrell Williams, Florence + The Machine, One Direction, Disclosure, and more.
- The Festival runs from September 19 through September 28 at the London Roundhouse, and just as Apple has done in past years, tickets to the concerts will be given away through a lottery system.
- It will also be available on the iPhone, iPad, and Apple TV thru dedicated apps, or via iTunes on your computer.

iPad Pro?



- There are a lot of rumors on the internet about Apple introducing a new iPad possibly called the iPad Pro.
- It would be a 12.9 inch iPad (Current iPads are 9.7 and 7.9 Inches)
- Other reported features: a Force Touch display, a stylus, and a possible USB-C connection???

Data Detectors



Data Detectors



- The idea is that you roll over certain types of data in Mail, you will see a dash outline around the data with an arrow facing down on its right edge.
- That means that Mail thinks the outlined text is a specific kind of data, and depending on the kind, you can do different useful things with it.
- Just click the arrow, then choose an option from the pop-up menu.

Track flights with iOS 9 and El Capitan



- Apple's new operating systems will allow you to keep tabs on airline flights with a new "Data Detector".
- If you have a flight number in your email, you'll be able to click on it (in OS X) or tap on it (in iOS 9) to track that flight.
- It will work in Mail, iMessage, and Notes.
- In Notes, type a legitimate flight number with the following format: Delta #2049.
- Hit Done and you'll see the flight number turn orange. Tap it and you'll have the option to Preview Flight. Tap that button and you'll get a full screen preview of where the flight is.








Data Detectors iOS



- Very similar except data that is detected shows up in blue and either pulls up a submenu or launches another app
- Be aware of data detectors and experiment with them. They can be major time savors.
- The short mail message to the right has II data detectors in it.







- To see and type special Characters via the option key


















- Use the Character Viewer to enter special characters including emojis.

- Older Macs or Older Windows devices may not see the characters.































My Apple Experiences





- On menu bar sound icon you can specify inputs/outputs













- And, if you lay it down on a table you get a left/right/ forward/back leveling tool











Quick Tip







